## TUITION

School year tuition is payable by the year, semester, or month, due on these dates:

Plan A (yearly): July 15, 2024.

Plan B (semester): July 15 & December 15, 2024.

Plan C (monthly): Equal monthly payments due the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month (August- April).

A late payment fee of 5% of the unpaid balance will be due after the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month.

#### ADDITIONAL HOURS

If approved in advance, parents may request additional hours beyond their enrollment agreement (before or after school) and will be charged \$16 per hour per child. Late pick-ups not approved in advance will be charged \$1 per minute.

# \*SCHOOL DAY HOURS

For the 2024-25 school year, the start and end times of the day will be staggered by age groups to allow for a carline-only drop-off and pick-up routine. The campus will be open from 7:45am-5:30pm including Extended Day hours.

### LUNCH

An optional lunch program for K-12<sup>th</sup> grades is available at the prices listed below.

To order on a day-to-day basis, the cost is \$6.50/day in advance or \$7.50/day on the day of the meal. Kindergarten–12<sup>th</sup> per child:

# SCHOOL YEAR FEES

School year fees vary by age group and may include textbooks, binders, agendas, classroom supplies, IXL subscription, field trips and transportation, technology, activity fee, parent alert, book club, and literacy circles. Upper School students are also expected to purchase a laptop for use in 9<sup>th</sup>–12<sup>th</sup> grades. Due May 15<sup>th</sup>.
